MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS

Senate Bill Nos. 1055, 1061, 1062, 1083, 1084, 1085, and 1095, S.D. 1, provide appropriations for Fiscal Years 2011-12 and 2012-13 for Hawaii Employer-Union Health Benefits Trust Fund costs for public employees negotiated in collective bargaining agreements.

We are not opposed to moving these bills. While the State is not in a position to fund general salary increases for public employees at this time, vehicle bills should be available to authorize other types of collective bargaining cost items should those be negotiated.
