The Hawaii State Teachers Association supports the intent of SB 1171.

We believe the Board of Education's authority to exempt certain public schools from the single school calendar should be related to reform plans. These exemptions are currently occurring in the Zones for School Innovation in Hawaii's Race to the Top application.

The actions for determining certain public school calendars to improve the educational outcomes in students should be represented through the collective bargaining process. Therefore, we support the intent of SB 1171.
