In 1996 Carmela founded Positive Moves, Inc. a 501c3 corporation. Positive Moves newest initiative began in Hawaii in 2011 to get millions of kids moving monthly by hosting it's first event, "Playday at the Beach with Malama." The goal is to provide personal training to all families and work more exclusively with children via webcam.

2. The goals and objectives related to the request;

The goals and objectives related to the request are to acquire grant funding enabling Positive Moves to host 3 events during the 2012-2013 budget period that follow the model of the pilot event held in October 2011, which was a free event where Hawaii's keiki 7-13 years olds were inspired to reconnect to the fun of being physically activity for 3 hours non-stop and electronics-free in an obstacle course of activities in the water, on the sand and land. Certificates, ribbons and grand prizes may be earned based on a point system.

3. State the public purpose and need to be served;

The project's timing is important right now, given the attention on the health of children in the U.S., including by First Lady Michelle Obama. And with the

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inundation of more organizations essentially offering more of the same...information, the time has come for Cool Kids Health Secrets Club, an organization that is in the business of delivery of service, hands-on support and accountability tracking that gives hands-on support and activities to children (and their families) inspiring a spirit and fun approach to being physically active regularly leading to a positive difference in their health and happiness allowing each child to reach their full physical, emotional, mental and spiritual potential.

4. Describe the target population to be served; and

The target population includes all 7-13 year old children and their parents or guardians

The geographic coverage for the actual events in 2012 includes various beaches/parks around Oahu. Any child from any island is eligible to participate based on meeting the age requirements.

A committee of 25 advisory team members organizes the day of the event logistics. Twenty-Five volunteers are used for the day of the event recruited from the high-school Key Clubs (Kiwanis Sponsored), as well as adult station leaders.

Upon participation in a playday, each family then has the opportunity to be supported weekly with a "being fit" curriculum offered directly into their "living room." Children and their families using live web on Skype, puts everyone on a level playing field providing economical, affordable and most of all private hands-on training and weekly exercise classes allowing the entire family to "be in motion" on a regular basis. Based on the requirement that at least one parent participate with their child ensures the safety of using live webcam and sets in motion the entire family participating. A body in motion can stay in motion for a lifetime and is the goal of this program.
