BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 707-700, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 2 3 and to read as follows: ""Vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 291E-1." 4 SECTION 2. Section 707-705, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 6 "(1) A person is guilty of the offense of negligent injury 7 in the first degree if that person causes serious bodily injury 8 9 to another person by the operation of a [motor] vehicle in a 10 negligent manner." SECTION 3. Section 707-706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 12 13 "(1) A person is guilty of the offense of negligent injury 14 in the second degree if that person causes substantial bodily injury to another person by the operation of a [motor] vehicle 15 16 in a negligent manner."

SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
 begun before its effective date.

5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
