A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIGARETTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that reduced ignition
2 propensity cigarettes are expected to reduce accidental fires
3 and related personal injury and property damage caused by
4 cigarette smoking.

5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
6 implementation of the reduced ignition propensity cigarette
7 certification pursuant to section 132C-4, Hawaii Revised
8 Statutes.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the temporary
10 deposits account in the trust fund of the department of labor
11 and industrial relations the sum of \$400,000 or so much thereof
12 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to be deposited to
13 the credit of the reduced ignition propensity cigarette program
14 special fund established pursuant to section 132C-9, Hawaii
15 Revised Statutes.

16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the reduced
17 ignition propensity cigarette program special fund the sum of
18 \$400,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year




1 2012-2013 for the purpose of funding one full-time
2 administrator, one full-time assistant, and other costs of
3 fulfilling the requirements of section 132C-4, Hawaii Revised
4 Statutes.

5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
6 labor and industrial relations.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
