

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$734,973 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for a
4 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of
5 the city and county of Honolulu for the career criminal
6 prosecution unit, including the hiring of necessary staff.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$121,057 or so much
9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for a
10 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of
11 the city and county of Honolulu for prosecution in drug court,
12 including the hiring of necessary staff.

13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$86,888 or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for a
16 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of
17 the city and county of Honolulu for the Hawaii's opportunity




1 probation with enforcement program, including the hiring of
2 necessary staff.

3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$502,965 or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 for a
6 grant-in-aid to the department of the prosecuting attorney of
7 the city and county of Honolulu for the victim witness
8 assistance program, including the hiring of necessary staff.

9 SECTION 5. The sums appropriated in sections 1, 2, 3, and
10 4 shall be expended by the department of the prosecuting
11 attorney of the city and county of Honolulu for the purposes of
12 this Act.

13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
