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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

PART I

SECTION 1. The following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2010-2011 are appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii to the department of the attorney general for the purpose of satisfying claims for legislative relief as to the following named persons, firms, corporations, and entities, for claims against the State or its officers or employees for the overpayment of taxes, or for refunds, reimbursements, payments of judgments or settlements, or other liabilities, in the amounts set forth opposite their names:

26 SECTION 3. The sums hereinabove may be paid to the  
27 respective persons, or for the satisfaction or settlement of the  
28 respectively identified cases, and in several amounts  
29 hereinabove set forth or in lesser amounts deemed appropriate,  
30 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided departments

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1 shall obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment  
2 of any claim can be made.

3 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as  
4 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest  
5 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if  
6 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,  
7 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those  
8 cases to which the statute applies.

9 SECTION 5. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the  
10 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on  
11 June 30, 2012, shall lapse.

12 SECTION 6. If any provision of this Act, or the  
13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held  
14 invalid, the invalidity does not effect other provisions or  
15 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the  
16 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions  
17 of this Act are severable.

18 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

**Description:**

Makes appropriations for claims against the State, its officers, and its employees.

JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Attorney General

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE, ITS OFFICERS, OR ITS EMPLOYEES.

PURPOSE: Provide for the authorization and payment of claims against the State for refunds of taxes, for judgments and settlements, and for other miscellaneous payments as provided by chapters 37, 661, and 662, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

MEANS: Authorize and appropriate funds for the payment of such claims.

JUSTIFICATION: This bill serves as the vehicle by which claims against the State are transmitted to the Legislature for its consideration. The Legislature will be asked to authorize and fund the payment of such claims by an appropriation of general and special funds. Timely passage of this bill will serve to minimize interest on those amounts for which interest is accruing.

Impact on the public: There would be no direct impact on the public other than the persons whose claims are being paid.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Claims eligible for payment from a special fund will generally be charged to that special fund rather than the general fund. Certain claims will be paid from a department's appropriation as reflected in the budget bill. In such case, that department will be responsible for finding the moneys in its budget to pay for the judgments and settlements rendered against it.

GENERAL FUND: \$331,253.71 to date, and additional claims

ultimately expected.

OTHER FUNDS: \$1,130,000.00 to date, additional funds ultimately expected.

PPBS PROGRAM DESIGNATION: Various.
