
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 437D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§437D- Additional driver fee prohibited; exception.
- 5 (a) No lessor or officer, employee, agent, or other
6 representative of the lessor shall assess a daily additional
7 driver fee against a lessor, except as otherwise provided in
8 this section.
- 9 (b) A lessor or officer, employee, agent, or other
10 representative of the lessor may assess, against any lessee who
11 is twenty-five years of age or older, a one-time, additional
12 driver fee of not more than \$10 for each additional driver. The
13 one-time fee shall be valid for the duration of the contract.
- 14 (c) The restriction on the assessment and collection of an
15 additional driver fee established in this section shall not
16 apply to any additional driver who is under twenty-five years
17 old."
- 18 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
