## A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
- 2 amendment to article X, section 2, of the Constitution of the
- 3 State of Hawaii to require the governor to appoint a student
- 4 member of the board of education, and to allow the student
- 5 member of the board of education to vote on all matters except
- 6 for personnel issues.
- 7 SECTION 2. Article X, section 2, of the Constitution of
- 8 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
- 9 "BOARD OF EDUCATION
- 10 Section 2. There shall be a board of education. The
- 11 governor shall nominate and, by and with the advice and consent
- 12 of the senate, appoint the members of the board of education, as
- 13 provided by law. The members shall include a public high school
- 14 student who shall have the right to vote on all matters before
- 15 the board except for those matters relating to personnel
- 16 issues."

1	SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
2	be as follows:
3	"Shall a student member of the board of education be
4	appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of
5	the senate, and be empowered to vote on all matters before
6	the board except for personnel issues?"
7	SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.
8	SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
9	compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
10	the State of Hawaii.
