A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAND USE COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§205- Conflict of interest. (a) Notwithstanding any		
5	provision of law to the contrary, if any member of the land use		
6	commission has had material personal involvement with a parcel		
7	of land that is the subject of action to be taken by the		
8	commission, the member shall disclose the nature of the material		
9	personal involvement and shall not vote or take any official		
10	action relating to that parcel of land.		
11	(b) For the purposes of this section:		
12	"Entity" has the same meaning as defined in section 245-1.		
13	"Material personal involvement" means:		
14	(1) The commissioner has at any time had ownership or		
15	tenancy rights attached to the parcel of land that is		
16	subject to a land use commission proceeding; or		

1	<u>(2)</u> <u>The</u>	commissioner has a relationship with a person or
2	enti	ty that controls the parcel of land that is
3	subj	ect to a land use commission proceeding where:
4	(A)	The commissioner is, or has been within the last
5		three years, an employee other than a benefit
6		officer of the person or entity or any of the
7		entity's subsidiaries; or
8	<u>(B)</u>	The commissioner is related by blood, marriage,
9		or adoption to; is a party to a civil union with;
10		is a reciprocal beneficiary or household member
11		of; or resides with an officer other than a
12		benefit officer or director of an entity or any
13		of its subsidiaries."
14	SECTION 2	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16	begun before i	ts effective date.
17	SECTION 3	. New statutory material is underscored.
18	SECTION 4	. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
