A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC PROCUREMENT CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 103D-707, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "\$103D-707 Remedies after an award. If after an award it
4 is determined that a solicitation or award of a contract is in
5 violation of law, provided that the violation of law entails an
6 error of at least \$10,000 for contracts less than \$1,000,000 or
7 an error of at least ten per cent of the estimated value of the
8 contract for contracts with an estimated value of \$1,000,000 or
9 more, then:

- 10 (1) If the person awarded the contract has not acted11 fraudulently or in bad faith:
- 12 (A) The <u>award of</u> contract may be ratified and
 13 affirmed, or modified; provided it is determined
 14 that doing so is in the best interests of the
 15 State; [or]
- 16 (B) The contract may be terminated and the person
 17 awarded the contract shall be compensated for the
 18 actual expenses, other than attorney's fees,
