
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$7,450,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal year
5 2012-2013, for the purpose of capital improvement projects for
6 the ninth representative district, as follows:

7 1. To be expended by the department of
8 land and natural resources:

9 A. Central Maui regional park \$5,000,000

10 Total funding \$5,000,000

11 B. West Maui watershed protection \$2,000,000

12 Total funding \$2,000,000

13 2. To be expended by the department of
14 education:

15 A. Maui high school, Maui

16 Plans and design for the Maui high

17 school multi-purpose room. \$250,000

8 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 9 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 10 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 11 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are
 12 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

13 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
 14 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by
 15 the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
