- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "<u>\$421J-</u> <u>Late fees.</u> A late fee charged to a member by
- 5 an association for association dues shall not be in an amount
- 6 that is more than ten per cent of the member's dues in arrears,
- 7 if the member's arrearage is for thirty days or less."
- 8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
