- 5 subpoena duces tecum, order, or other notice requiring the
- 6 appearance of a witness."
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 9 begun before its effective date.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
