
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS IN CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 836-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "summons" to read as
3 follows:


4 "Summons" includes a subpoena[7] ad testificandum and
5 subpoena duces tecum, order, or other notice requiring the
6 appearance of a witness."

7 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
9 begun before its effective date.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
