
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIGARETTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to make an
2 appropriation for the implementation of the reduced ignition
3 propensity cigarette certification pursuant to section 134C-4,
4 Hawaii Revised Statutes. Certified cigarettes are expected to
5 reduce accidental fires and related personal injury and property
6 damage caused by cigarette smoking.

7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the reduced
8 ignition propensity cigarette program special fund the sum of
9 \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal
10 year 2012-2013 for the purpose of funding one full-time
11 administrator, one full-time assistant, and other costs of
12 fulfilling the requirements of section 132C-4, Hawaii Revised
13 Statutes.

14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
15 labor and industrial relations.



1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
