BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to make an
- 2 appropriation for the implementation of the reduced ignition
- 3 propensity cigarette certification pursuant to section 134C-4,
- 4 Hawaii Revised Statutes. Certified cigarettes are expected to
- 5 reduce accidental fires and related personal injury and property
- 6 damage caused by cigarette smoking.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the reduced
- 8 ignition propensity cigarette program special fund the sum of
- 9 \$400,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal
- 10 year 2012-2013 for the purpose of funding one full-time
- 11 administrator, one full-time assistant, and other costs of
- 12 fulfilling the requirements of section 132C-4, Hawaii Revised
- 13 Statutes.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 labor and industrial relations.
