
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIGARETTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that reduced ignition
2 propensity cigarettes are expected to reduce accidental fires
3 and related personal injury and property damage caused by
4 cigarette smoking. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
5 funds for the implementation of the reduced ignition propensity
6 cigarette certification pursuant to section 132C-4, Hawaii
7 Revised Statutes.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the reduced
9 ignition propensity cigarette program special fund the sum of
10 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
11 2012-2013 for the purpose of funding one full-time
12 administrator, one full-time assistant, and other costs of
13 fulfilling the requirements of section 132C-4, Hawaii Revised
14 Statutes.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
16 labor and industrial relations.

17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
