1 SECTION 1. Chapter 338, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§338- Certificates; English and Hawaiian languages. 5 (a) Certificates of birth, marriage, divorce, or death issued 6 by the department of health that contain Hawaiian names shall 7 contain proper diacritical marks and shall be provided as 8 quickly as certificates that contain English names. 9 (b) The department of health may adopt rules pursuant to **10** chapter 91 to effectuate this section." 11 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
