# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part VI to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§286-           Driver's license; driving under the influence of  
5 an intoxicant symbol. (a) The examiner of drivers shall place  
6 a symbol on any issued or renewed license to indicate that the  
7 licensee has been convicted of operating a vehicle under the  
8 influence of an intoxicant. Evidence of this symbol shall not  
9 be admissible in any judicial proceeding, administrative  
10 proceeding, arbitration proceeding, or other adjudicatory  
11 proceeding pursuant to section 281-78.




12           (b) The same symbol shall be used statewide."

13           SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

14           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
