A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 431:10C-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
2	is amende	ed by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	Every insurer shall issue to its insureds a motor
4	vehicle i	nsurance identification card for each motor vehicle for
5	which the	basic motor vehicle insurance coverage is written.
6	The ident	ification card shall contain the following:
7	(1)	Name of make and factory or serial number of the motor
8		vehicle; provided that insurers of five or more motor
9		vehicles which are under common registered ownership
10		and used in the regular course of business shall not
11		be required to indicate the name of make and the
12		factory or serial number of each motor vehicle;
13	(2)	Policy number;
14	(3)	Names of the insured and the insurer; [and]
15	(4)	Effective dates of coverage including the expiration
16		date[-]; and
17	(5)	A magnetic strip or microchip on the card that will
18		allow retail service stations to determine whether the

2		the retail service station dispenses gasoline into the

4	SECT	ION 2. (a) The insurance commissioner shall adopt
5	rules pur	suant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
6	implement	this Act which shall include, but not be limited to
7	the follo	wing:
8	(1)	Motor vehicle insurance companies shall be required to
9		issue motor vehicle insurance identification cards to
10		its insureds in this State containing a magnetic strip
11		or microchip that will permit retail service stations
12	•	to determine whether the motor vehicle insurance
13		coverage is in force before the retail service station
14		dispenses gasoline into the motor vehicle;
15	(2)	Motor vehicle insurance companies shall be required to
16		create and keep current a database of motor vehicle
17		insurance policies that will be accessible by retail
18		service stations through the magnetic strip or
19		microchip on a motor vehicle insurance identification
20		card only for the purpose of determining whether the
21		motor vehicle insurance coverage is in force at the
22		time the determination is to be made;

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1	(3)	No gasoline shall be dispensed into a motor vehicle	
2		unless there is motor vehicle insurance in force at	
3		the time the gasoline is to be dispensed, as	
4		determined through the person's motor vehicle	
5		insurance identification card; and	
6	(4)	The motor vehicle insurance verification requirement	
7		shall not apply when the gasoline is to be dispensed	
8		into an approved gasoline container or into a vehicle	
9		not covered by the motor vehicle insurance	
10		requirement.	
11	(b)	The insurance commissioner shall make the proposed	
12	rules ava	ilable for public hearing no later than January 1,	
13	2013. The	e rules implementing this Act shall take effect on July	
14	1, 2013.		
15	SECT	ION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;		
18	provided that section 1 shall take effect on July 1, 2013.

Motor Vehicle Insurance Cards; Verification Of Insurance At Service Stations

Description:

Requires motor vehicle insurance companies to issue insurance cards with a magnetic strip or microchip to allow retail service stations to determine whether a gasoline purchaser's motor vehicle insurance is current. Requires the insurance commissioner to adopt rules to implement the requirement, including exemptions.
