
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3 "(a) Any person who renders a proper statement for goods
4 delivered or services performed, pursuant to contract, to any
5 agency of the State or any county, shall be paid no later than
6 thirty calendar days following receipt of the statement or
7 satisfactory delivery of the goods or performance of the
8 services. In the event circumstances prevent the paying agency
9 from complying with this section, the person shall be entitled
10 to interest from the paying agency on the principal amount
11 remaining unpaid at a rate equal to the prime rate for each
12 calendar quarter plus two per cent[-]; provided that an operator
13 of an adult day care facility, community care foster family
14 home, or adult residential care home shall be entitled to
15 interest from the paying agency on the principal amount
16 remaining unpaid at a rate of for each calendar quarter
17 commencing on the thirtieth day following receipt of the
18 statement or satisfactory delivery of the goods or performance



1 of the services, whichever is later, and ending on the date of
2 the check. As used in this subsection, "prime rate" means the
3 prime rate as posted in the Wall Street Journal on the first
4 business day of the month preceding the calendar quarter."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
