## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 712-1250.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (4) to read as follows:

3           "(4) Promoting intoxicating liquor to a person under the  
4 age of twenty-one is a petty misdemeanor. Any person convicted  
5 of violating this section shall be sentenced as follows:

6           (a) For a first conviction, the person shall serve a  
7           minimum term of imprisonment of no less than twenty-  
8           four hours;

9           (b) For a second conviction within five years, the person  
10           may serve a term of imprisonment of no fewer than  
11           twenty days; and

12           (c) For a third or subsequent conviction within five  
13           years, the person may serve a term of imprisonment of  
14           no fewer than thirty days."

15           SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
17 begun, before its effective date.

18           SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

**Report Title:**

Promoting Liquor to Minors; Sentencing

**Description:**

Changes classification of the offense of promoting intoxicating liquor to a minor from misdemeanor to a petty misdemeanor. Requires a minimum 24-hour imprisonment for the first offense. Authorizes longer imprisonment term for second, third, and subsequent offenses.
