
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address economic
2 development by establishing, as state policy, an intent to
3 complete or facilitate the completion of a list of ten specific
4 projects within the next ten-year period.

5 SECTION 2. Chapter 226, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
7 to read as follows:

8 "PART . PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED BY DECEMBER 31, 2023

9 §226- Ten projects to be completed by December 31,
10 2023. It is the policy of the State to complete or facilitate
11 the completion of the following projects by December 31, 2023:

12 (1) Broadband infrastructure that provides coverage for
13 one hundred per cent of the following land areas in
14 the State: land zoned for business, commercial,
15 industrial, hotel, or resort use and land used for
16 higher education instruction or research;




- 1 (2) The airport modernization project of the department of
2 transportation, as planned as of the effective date of
3 this section;
- 4 (3) The harbor modernization project of the department of
5 transportation, as planned as of the effective date of
6 this section;
- 7 (4) The thirty-meter telescope on Mauna Kea;
- 8 (5) A regional bio-hazard laboratory under the University
9 of Hawaii;
- 10 (6) The Diamond Head culinary institute on the slope of
11 Diamond Head;
- 12 (7) The 690 Pohukaina street mixed use transit oriented
13 development project;
- 14 (8) The locally preferred alternative mass transit system
15 of the city and county of Honolulu;
- 16 (9) Renewable energy production facilities that are
17 sufficient to meet the goals of the first decade of
18 the Hawaii clean energy initiative; and
- 19 (10) A community college campus in West Hawaii."



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
