# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. Section 249-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "OTHER LEVIES

4  
5 **§249-31 State registration fee.** (a) All vehicles and  
6 motor vehicles in the State as defined in section 249-1,  
7 including antique motor vehicles, except as otherwise provided  
8 in sections 249-4 and 249-6, shall be subject to a [~~\$45~~] \$35  
9 annual vehicle registration fee. The fee shall be paid each  
10 year together with all other taxes and fees levied by this  
11 chapter on a staggered basis as established by each county as  
12 authorized by section 286-51, and the state registration for  
13 that county shall likewise be staggered so that the state  
14 registration fee is due and payable at the same time and shall  
15 be collected together with the county fee. The state  
16 registration fee shall be deemed delinquent if not paid with the  
17 county registration fee. The respective counties shall collect  
18 this fee together with the vehicle registration tax collected

1 for the county and shall transfer the moneys collected under  
2 this section to the State.

3 (b) From each annual motor vehicle registration fee, the  
4 director shall deposit [~~\$40~~] \$30 into the state highway fund and  
5 \$5 into the emergency medical services special fund."

6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
