
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRONIC WASTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 339D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:

3 "(c) By June 1, 2009, and annually thereafter, each
4 electronic device manufacturer shall submit a plan to the
5 department to establish, conduct, and manage a program for the
6 collection, transportation, and recycling of its covered
7 electronic devices sold in the State, which shall be subject to
8 the following conditions:

9 (1) The plan shall not permit the charging of a fee at the
10 point of recycling if the covered electronic device is
11 brought by the covered electronic device owner to a
12 central location for recycling; provided that the plan
13 may include a reasonable transportation fee if the
14 electronic device manufacturer or electronic device
15 manufacturer's agent removes the covered electronic
16 device from the owner's premises at the owner's
17 request and if the removal is not in conjunction with



1 delivery of a new electronic device to the owner;

2 [and]

3 (2) The plan shall not provide a program limited only to
4 mail-back of covered electronic devices;

5 (3) At a minimum, the plan shall provide for collection of
6 covered electronic devices at monthly collection
7 events or regular collection sites open at least two
8 days per week, including one weekend day, within not
9 more than sixty miles from a high density population
10 area as defined by the department in rules; and

11 (4) Each electronic device manufacturer may develop its
12 own recycling program or may collaborate with other
13 electronic device manufacturers, so long as the
14 program is implemented and fully operational no later
15 than January 1, 2010.

16 (d) By March 31, 2011, and annually thereafter, each
17 electronic device manufacturer shall submit to the department
18 the total weight of all covered electronic devices recycled in
19 the previous year[7] by county and type of covered electronic
20 device, which may include both an electronic device
21 manufacturer's own covered electronic devices and those of other
22 manufacturers."
