BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 17-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

(1) If it occurs not later than on the [sixtieth] seventyfifth day prior to the next succeeding special

designating the election for filling the vacancy. All

candidates for the unexpired term shall file

nomination papers not later than 4:30 p.m. on the

1 immediately preceding) and shall be elected in 2 accordance with this title. Pending the election, the 3 board or the governor shall make a temporary appointment to fill the vacancy in the manner 4 5 prescribed under subsection (a). When island 6 residency is required under section 13D-1, the person so appointed shall reside on the island from which the 8 vacancy occurred, and shall serve for the duration of 9 the unexpired term and shall serve until the election 10 of the person duly elected to fill such vacancy. 11 (2) If it occurs after the [sixtieth] seventy-fifth day 12 prior to the next succeeding special election held in conjunction with the general election, the board or 13 14 the governor shall make an appointment to fill the vacancy in the manner prescribed under subsection (a). 15 16 When island residency is required under section 13D-1, 17 the person so appointed shall reside on the island 18 from which the vacancy occurred, and shall serve for the duration of the unexpired term." 19
