A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY ENVIRONMENTAL WORKFORCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that threats to Hawaii's
- 2 natural resources and watersheds, such as invasive species,
- 3 require a rapid response to mitigate environmental damage and
- 4 prevent far higher costs that may be needed if the threat is
- 5 allowed to expand.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to establish a special
- 7 operations team authorized to recruit a temporary workforce to
- 8 respond to environmental emergencies.
- 9 SECTION 2. (a) There is established a special operations
- 10 team that shall be responsible for responding to environmental
- 11 emergencies by recruiting temporary emergency environmental
- 12 workforce employees through the research corporation of the
- 13 university of Hawaii. The special operations team shall provide
- 14 environmental emergency response services including but not
- 15 limited to eradication of invasive species.
- 16 The special operations team shall be chaired by the
- 17 chairperson of the board of land and natural resources and shall
- 18 include the following members:
