4	(b) The genealogies manager shall:
5	(1) Gather, verify, and create a database of genealogies
6	for persons who have claims to kuleana lands; and
7	(2) Consult and coordinate with the department of land and
8	natural resources, the land division, the bureau of
9	conveyances, and the land court to identify kuleana
10	lands for which title has been quieted in favor of
11	non-native Hawaiians.
12	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
14	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013 to
15	establish one full-time equivalent permanent genealogies manager
16	position within the office of Hawaiian affairs.
