A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that current difficult 2 economic conditions warrant the use of incentives to help create 3 job growth and stimulate the State's economy. The legislature 4 also finds that the process for procuring state contracts is 5 often cumbersome. The legislature further finds that incentives 6 in the procurement process would lead to more companies bidding 7 for state contracts. This would give the State a broader 8 network of contractors to choose from and would possibly 9 expedite the progress of rebuilding Hawaii's economy and 10 workforce by having a number of companies working on various 11 state projects. 12 The purpose of this Act is to create price preferences for 13 bids and proposals submitted to procuring agencies by Hawaii
- 14 small businesses, veterans, and disabled veterans.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 103D-906, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "[+]\$103D-906[+] Preference for Hawaii small businesses[+
- 18 set-asides; use as subcontractors.] (a) The policy board shall

3	[(1)	Set-asides for small businesses in appropriate
4		classifications of requirements suitable to
5		performance by small businesses; and
6	(2)	Criteria designed to encourage the use of small
7		businesses as-subcontractors on large-contracts.]
8	(1)	A five per cent price preference for small businesses
9		other than those described in paragraphs (2) and (3);
10	(2)	A seven per cent price preference for veterans; and
11	<u>(3)</u>	A nine per cent price preference for disabled
12		veterans.
13	The	rules adopted pursuant to this section shall include
14	rules for	verifying the status and eligibility of veterans and
15	disabled	veterans.
16	(b)	As used in this section:
17	<u>"Haw</u>	aii small business" means a small business as defined
18	in section 103D-901, having:	
19	(1)	Its principal place of business or ancillary
20		headquarters located within the State; and
21	(2)	Not less than thirty-five per cent of its employees
22		residing within the State.

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1 "Disabled veteran" means a veteran who has a service-2 related disability that has been verified by the United States 3 Department of Veterans Affairs and who meets any other 4 applicable qualifications established by rule. 5 "Veteran" means any person who has served in any of the 6 armed services of the United States in any war or campaign in 7 which the United States was engaged, whose service has been 8 verified by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, 9 and who meets any other applicable qualifications established by 10 rule." 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 14 INTRODUCED BY:
