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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
THIRTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,919,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-  
6 eighth representative district, as follows:

9 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

10 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital  
11 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by  
12 the designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
