A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AGRIBUSINESS COOPERATIVE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that local farmers have 2 difficulty distributing their products to large retail 3 establishments. 4 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of agriculture to convene a task force to conduct a study on 5 whether an agribusiness cooperative program should be 6 established. 7 8 SECTION 2. (a) The department of agriculture shall 9 convene a task force to conduct a study on whether an agribusiness cooperative program that includes the following 10 functions should be established to promote the distribution of 11 12 local farm products to large retailers: Assist local farmers in increasing the distribution of (1)13 products to large retail establishments; and 14 Develop feed mills located in this State to lower farm (2) 15

expenses and minimize the carbon impact of

transporting feed imports to local farmers.

- "Local farmer" refers to a farmer whose farm is located in
 Hawaii.
- 20 SECTION 3. The task force shall report its findings and 21 recommendations to the legislature no later than twenty days 22 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2013.
