#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 398-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
 and to read as follows:

4 ""Sibling" means a biological or adoptive brother or 5 sister."

6 SECTION 2. Section 398-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

8 "(a) An employee shall be entitled to a total of four
9 weeks of family leave during any calendar year upon the birth of
10 a child of the employee or the adoption of a child, or to care
11 for the employee's child, <u>sibling</u>, spouse or reciprocal
12 beneficiary, or parent with a serious health condition."
13 SECTION 3. Section 398-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
14 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

"(c) When leave is to care for a child, <u>sibling</u>, spouse,
or parent who has a serious health condition, certification
shall be issued by the health care provider of the individual

1 requiring care. Certification shall be considered sufficient if

2 it provides information as required by the director."

3 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
