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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FORTY-EIGHTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$3,170,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the forty-  
6 eighth representative district, as follows:

7           To be expended by the department of  
8 education

9       1. James B. Castle high school

10       A. Replace the lighting system, sound  
11           system, and carpeting, and re-

 21 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.




1           SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
