## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to provide 2 flexibility to the ex officio voting members of the board of agriculture by allowing these members to send one designated 3 representative each on their behalf to board of agriculture 4 5 meetings when these members are unable to attend. It is not, 6 however, the intent of the legislature that these ex officio 7 voting members rely solely on the attendance of their designated 8 representatives in carrying out their statutory duty to serve on 9 the board of agriculture. In addition, it is the intent of the 10 legislature that on occasions where a designated representative 11 attends a meeting on behalf of the ex officio voting member, the 12 designated representative be a person who has the agricultural 13 background and experience necessary to actively participate in 14 the discussion and decision making of the board of agriculture. 15 SECTION 2. Section 26-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

13		representatives, who shall serve as [an] ex officio
14		voting [member;] members.
15	[ <del>(6)</del>	The director of business, economic development, and
16		tourism, who shall serve as an ex officio voting
17		member; and
18	<del>(7)</del>	The dean of the University of Hawaii college of
19		tropical agriculture and human resources, who shall
20		serve as an ex officio voting member.]
21	The major	ity of the members of the board shall be from the
22	agricultu	ral community or the agricultural support sector. The

- 1 appointment, tenure, and removal of the members and the filling
- 2 of vacancies on the board shall be as provided in section 26-34.
- 3 The governor shall appoint a chairperson of the board from the
- 4 members."
- 5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
