
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACT PROPOSALS FOR CHILD CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103F-401.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) No contract proposals shall be accepted from any
4 applicant who lacks any license necessary to conduct the
5 business being sought by the request for proposals~~[-]~~, except
6 for proposals from applicants to operate a child care program
7 required to be licensed pursuant to section 346-161."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
