
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION FOR TEMPORARY DISABILITY INSURANCE
CLAIMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 392-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[~~f~~]**\$392-51**[~~}]~~ **Failure to submit timely wage and**
4 **employment information.** An employer to whom an insurer or an
5 employee has sent a request for information on wages, hours, and
6 duration of employment regarding an employee claiming disability
7 benefits shall complete and submit to the requestor such
8 information within seven days from the date the request was
9 received. If the employer fails to submit such information
10 within seven days, the director upon notification by the insurer
11 or the employee shall levy a penalty of [~~\$10 for each delinquent~~
12 ~~request~~]:

13 (1) \$250 for a first delinquent request; and

14 (2) \$500 for a second or subsequent delinquent request,

15 where the employer fails to show good cause for failure to file
16 on time."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Requires an employer to submit the Employer's Statement portion

upon request. Increases the fine for failure to provide
