A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INFORMATION FOR TEMPORARY DISABILITY INSURANCE CLAIMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 392-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$392-51[+] Failure to submit timely wage and
- 4 employment information. An employer to whom an insurer or an
- 5 employee has sent a request for information on wages, hours, and
- 6 duration of employment regarding an employee claiming disability
- 7 benefits shall complete and submit to the requestor such
- 8 information within seven days from the date the request was
- 9 received. If the employer fails to submit such information
- 10 within seven days, the director upon notification by the insurer
- 11 or the employee shall levy a penalty of [\$10 for each delinquent
- 12 request]:
- 13 (1) \$250 for a first delinquent request; and
- 14 (2) \$500 for a second or subsequent delinquent request,
- 15 where the employer fails to show good cause for failure to file
- 16 on time."

- 1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Temporary Disability Insurance; Submission of Wage and Employment Information

Description:

Requires an employer to submit the Employer's Statement portion of a Temporary Disability Insurance claim form to the employee upon request. Increases the fine for failure to provide information in a timely manner to \$250 for a first delinquent request and \$500 for a second or subsequent delinquent request. (HB2579 HD1)

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
