#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 291-37, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

"§291-37 Penalties. (a) Any person who omits to perform
any of the acts required by, or who commits any of the acts
prohibited by, sections 291-2 to 291-33[7] and 291-35.1, or any
rules adopted to enforce those sections, shall be guilty of a
violation and shall be fined not less than \$25 nor more than
\$1,800, except as otherwise provided.

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All penalties imposed and collected for violations of
 sections 291-33 to 291-36, except 291-35.1, shall be paid into
 the state highway fund.

The department of transportation shall institute a system where the fine, based on the tables in this subsection, may be mailed in when the citation or penalty is not to be contested. This system shall include an ability for the owner of the vehicle or combination of vehicles to request the operator be held harmless and the citation be transferred to that owner of the vehicle or combination of vehicles.

(b) When a vehicle or combination of vehicles including 11 load is found to be in violation of any provision contained in 12 13 sections 291-33 to 291-36, except 291-35.1, and the operator of 14 such vehicle or combination of vehicles is a subordinate or employee, the courts shall take judicial notice of this relative 15 subordinate position and, conditions warranting, hold the 16 operator harmless and impose the applicable penalties against 17 the owner of the vehicle or combination of vehicles. The owner 18 of the vehicle or combination of vehicles shall mean persons or 19 officers of firms or corporations, who owns the transporting 20 21 vehicle or who operates the vehicle under a bona fide lease 22 agreement."

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#### JUSTIFICATION SHEET

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DEPARTMENT :

Transportation

TITLE:	A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PENALTIES.
PURPOSE:	Establish a penalty provision for persons who violate the bumper requirements of Section 291-35.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
MEANS:	Amend section 291-37, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
JUSTIFICATION:	Section 291-35.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, was enacted in order to prevent motorists from modifying their vehicles in a manner that would raise the bumper height to an extent that it would cause higher than normal probability of an injury in the event of a crash into the front or rear of the modified vehicle. This section currently does not have a penalty for violations. A penalty is needed in order to motivate motorists to comply with the law.
	Impact on the public: Imposing a penalty for violating section 291-35.1 could lessen the likelihood of injury in a crash involving modified vehicles.
	Impact on the department and other agencies: There will be no impact on the Department of Transportation. The police departments may possibly issue more citations for violations if there is a penalty for the violations.
