[-(a)-] Within three days after a 5 mortgagee serves a foreclosure notice on an owner-occupant pursuant to section 667-5 or 667-22, the mortgagee shall file 6 the foreclosure notice with the department and pay a filing fee 7 of \$250, which shall be deposited into the mortgage foreclosure 8 dispute resolution special fund established under section 667-9. 10 86.

11 [-(b)--Violation of this section shall constitute an unfair 12 and deceptive-act-or practice subject to section 480-2.]" 13 SECTION 2. Section 667-60, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 repealed.

15 ["[§667-60] Unfair or deceptive-act-or practice. Any 16 foreclosing mortgagee who violates this chapter shall have 17 committed-an unfair or deceptive act or practice-under section 18 480-2."]
