1 SECTION 2. The sum appropriated for the respective capital
2 improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by
3 the designated agencies for the purposes of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
5 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
6 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
