## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 1 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: "§11- Campaign defamation. (a) A person commits the 4 5 offense of campaign defamation if, through campaign material, the person publishes to a third party: 6 7 A false statement; With actual malice or reckless disregard of the truth; 8 (2) 9 and 10 That the publisher knew or should have known to be (3) 11 false. 12 (b) It is an affirmative defense to a prosecution under 13 subsection (a) that the statement is true. (c) Campaign defamation is a misdemeanor." 14 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 17 begun before its effective date. SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored. 18
