
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FORTY-SIXTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$70,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the benefit
6 of the forty-sixth representative district, as follows:

7 A. Waialua elementary school, Oahu

8 (1) Equipment and appurtenances for the new
9 library/media center.

10 Equipment	<u>\$70,000</u>
11 Total funding	\$70,000

12 SECTION 2. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
13 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

14 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
15 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
16 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is



1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
