# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$77,250,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the second  
6 representative district, as follows:

7       1. To be expended by the department of  
8 education:

9       A. Hilo high school, Hawaii

10             Design and construction for  
11             renovation of the auditorium.

12             Design                             \$ 375,000

13             Construction                         2,125,000

14                     Total funding                             \$2,500,000

15       B. Hilo high school, Hawaii

19 Project to include ground and site  
20 improvements, development of new  
21 facility, equipment, and  
22 appurtenances, and all related



1 project costs. Project is deemed  
 2 necessary to qualify for federal  
 3 aid financing and reimbursement;  
 4 provided that no funds shall be  
 5 expended unless the University of  
 6 Hawaii at Hilo provides at least  
 7 \$5,000,000 in matching funds.

8 Plans, design, and  
 9 construction \$33,000,000

10 Total funding \$33,000,000

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital  
 12 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 13 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
 14 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are  
 15 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

16 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 17 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
 18 expended by the designated expending agencies for the purposes  
 19 of this Act.




