### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Mililani and Waipio Gentry, located in the
- 2 thirty-seventh representative district, encompass the new and
- 3 expanding areas of Waipio Gentry and older areas of Mililani.
- 4 Aging and deteriorating school facilities in the district and
- 5 the public library require repair and maintenance to ensure that
- 6 these facilities meet the educational needs of youth in the
- 7 community and the community at large. Sidewalks along
- 8 Kamehameha highway are also required for pedestrian safety.

- 10 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are
- 11 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of
- 12 Hawaii for fiscal year 2012-2013:
