
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to address state
2 funds by authorizing the transfer of excess moneys in the
3 agricultural loan revolving fund to the pest inspection,
4 quarantine, and eradication fund. This Act appropriates the
5 transferred moneys for an agricultural program.

6 SECTION 2. The legislature determines that there is in the
7 agricultural loan revolving fund at least \$140,000 in excess of
8 the requirements of the fund. At any time during fiscal year
9 2012-2013, the director of finance is authorized to transfer
10 from the agricultural loan revolving fund to the pest
11 inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund the sum of \$140,000
12 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-
13 2013.

14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the pest
15 inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund the sum of \$140,000
16 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2012-2013
17 for a program to control and eradicate the coffee borer beetle,
18 including the destruction of feral coffee trees.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.



Report Title:

Agricultural Loan Revolving Fund; Coffee Borer Beetle Program

Description:

Authorizes the transfer during fiscal year 2012-13 of \$140,000 from the Agricultural Loan Revolving Fund to the Pest Inspection, Quarantine, and Eradication Fund. Appropriates \$140,000 for a program to control and eradicate the coffee borer beetle. Effective July 1, 2012. (HB283 HD1)

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
