- 12 (b) A law enforcement officer having reasonable grounds to
- 13 believe that a released defendant has committed a crime under
- 14 the laws of the federal government, the State, or any of its
- 15 counties during the period of release on bail, recognizance, or
- 16 supervised release, may, where it would be impracticable to
- **17** secure a warrant, arrest the defendant and take the defendant
- 18 forthwith before the court of record.
