BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The appropriation made for the capital 2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made; 3 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are 4 5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date. 6 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act shall be 7 8 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of 9 this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
