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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
NINETEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$34,344,800 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 nineteenth representative district, as follows:

3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
4 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are  
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital  
7 improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act shall be  
8 expended by the designated expending agency for the purposes of  
9 this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
