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## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
THIRTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$39,923,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2012-2013  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 thirteenth representative district, as follows:

7       1. To be expended by the department of accounting and general  
8 services:

9           Huelo community center, Maui

10                  Planning, design, and construction

11                  of a Huelo community center;

12                  provided that the county of Maui

13                  match the funds appropriated by

14                  the State

16       2. To be expended by the department of defense:

17           Molokai veteran's center

17            SECTION 2.   The appropriation made for the capital

18            improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at

19            the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;

20            provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are

21            unencumbered as of June 30, 2014, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the respective capital  
2 improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act shall be  
3 expended by the designated expending agencies for the purposes  
4 of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
